

# Upcycle Enterprise Innovation Competition 2020

Veale Youth Entrepreneurship Forum school students may enter the competition portion of the Upcycle Enterprise Innovation program via our website: <https://www.vealeentrepreneurs.org/upcycle-enterprise-innovation-competition-submissions/>.

All entries must be received by midnight on Sunday, November 15, 2020 to be eligible for the contest.

Prizes will be awarded to the top two entries from each participating VYEF school.

An overall competition prize will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>.

An individual who wins an overall prize is not eligible for a school specific prize.

Only VYEF school students are eligible for prizes.

## Prize breakdown

\$250 Gift Card – Overall Top Winner

\$150 Gift Card – Overall Second Place

\$100 Gift Card – Overall Third Place

\$50 Gift Card each – VYEF Participating School Top Submission

\$25 Gift Card each – VYEF Participating School Second Place Submission

## Judging

All entries will be scored in totality across the competition and based on a numeric score from the judging rubric provided on the website.

VYEF & Upcycle staff will independently score initial submissions to produce top 20 submissions and to award 2 top participants from each school.

Guest judges will score the top 20 entries to produce the overall winners.

## Rules & Eligibility

- All competitors must be in Grades 9-12 and actively enrolled in a Veale Youth Entrepreneurship Forum high school in the Fall of 2020. They must remain in good academic

standing throughout the challenge. Entrants must be aged thirteen (13) years or older at the time of entry.

- Submitting multiple entries is prohibited.
- Only original ideas and materials that have been conceived of and created by the competitor(s) may be submitted.
- Entries may not contain material that violates or infringes another's rights, including but not limited to privacy, publicity, copyright, trademark, patent, intellectual property-related rights, or property-related rights.
- Applicant and his/her parent/guardian must give consent to all photographs, audio recordings and video recordings taken of him/her, and all Challenge and Summit work presented in association with the Veale Youth Entrepreneurship Forum (VYEF). All submissions and attachments become the property of VYEF and may be used by VYEF for educational, instructional or promotional purposes in print, broadcast or electronic media formats now existing or in the future created. This includes but is not limited to any video entry submission. There will be no compensation for the use of any photographs, audio or video recordings or any other media.
- All State, Local, Federal and or other taxes, duties, tariffs, title fees, licensing fees, or other fees for prizes awarded in any contest become the sole responsibility of the winner.
- Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify any contest, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the contest/sweepstakes, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner.

## **Submission Procedures**

- All information submitted through the portal must be in English.
- All due dates are posted on the webpage.
- Entries must be received by 11:59 pm on the due date published on the webpage.
- Entries are to be submitted online via the webpage.
- Submissions should be limited to the requested information.
